Addiction is an illness that affects both brain and behavior; it disrupts messaging pathways in the brain causing profound behavioral changes characteristic of the condition. Come learn about how this disruption in messaging helps to explain both the symptoms of addiction and why it is so difficult to treat.

- the disruption of the of the brain's signaling system that leads to the illness of addiction and associated behaviors
- risk factors associated with developing addiction
- the physiological development of "triggers"
- the most effective evidence-based approaches for treating the illness of addiction
